

## **IN ONE PLACE ONLY** Unique and semi-unique features within the Census Bureau's web pages

Almost every feature of the Census Bureau's web pages can be found in more than one place. For example, you can find *Population Estimates* from both the Population Estimates homepage and from the American Factfinder homepage.

But there are some important features of the Census web pages that can be found only in one place.

### **PERCENTAGES**

Most Census data is numeric. But Census provides percentage information for a subset of their data. This can be found by opening the "Geographic Comparison Tables" of Summary Files 1-4 and the other files that you can find GCTs for on the "Data Sets" webpage.

### **LAND AREA AND WATER AREA**

This data is available only in 1. the Geographic Comparison Tables of Summary File One, and 2. via the "Find an Area Profile with *Quickfacts*" tool on the right side of the Census homepage (with this tool you will find "Land Area" only).

### **DENSITY OF POPULATION**

This data is available only in the Geographic Comparison Tables of Summary File One. It will be the last file within any geography you're searching in.
